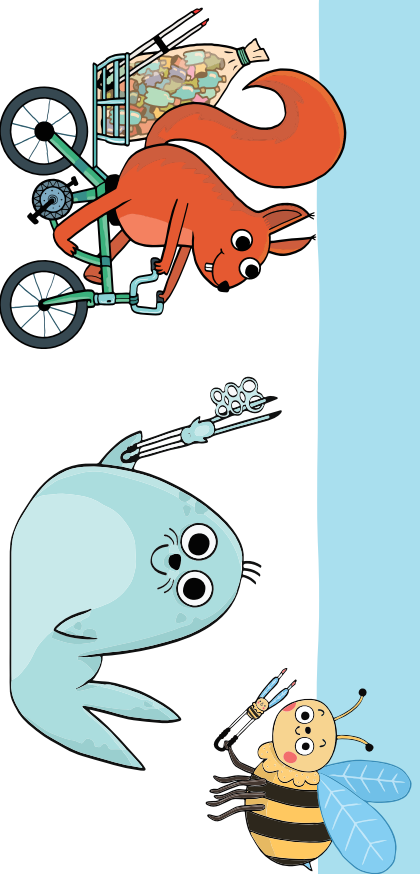


Safety Information

STAY SAFE, PICKER PALS

To Big Picker Pals:

- Read this Safety Information before you take a child on a litter-picking adventure.
- Picking should not be done on busy roads. Parks, greens, playgrounds and beaches are good places to litter-pick with children.
- Litter-pick in close company with your child, making sure that they are working safely.
- Gloves and hi-vis jackets should be worn at all times.
- Suitable clothing and footwear should be worn.
- Always use picker-uppers to pick up litter.
- Picking should not be done after dusk.
- Do not allow your child to pick up sharp, dangerous or unpleasant items.
- Observe COVID-19 advice for safe litter-picking.

To Little Picker Pals:

- Read this with your adult.
- Stay close to your adult at all times.
- Don't go picking near busy roads.
- Don't pick up things if you don't know what they are. If you're not sure, ask your adult.
- Always use your picker-upper to pick up litter.
- Don't pick up sharp or horrible things.
- Always wear your hi-vis vest and gloves.
- Wear the right clothes and safe shoes or boots.
- Wash your hands after your litter-picking adventure.
